“What can Applied Linguistics offer to English language teachers?”

講演 内容

This workshop will begin with a matching exercise to present 10 ‘dead end’ beliefs about language that are commonly encountered in English language teaching (ELT). We will briefly consider some definitions of Applied Linguistics and the relationship between the academic discipline and the practice of ELT. Then we will return to the 10 dead ends and discuss each one in turn. We will think about the possible implications of the dead ends for ELT and then, finally, sum up by listing the benefits for teachers (and drawbacks) of identifying as Applied Linguists.



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Dr. Rachel Wicaksono has been involved in teaching English, teacher training, research, and project and school management in India, Indonesia, Sri Lanka, Pakistan, China, Japan, Hong Kong, Vietnam, Sweden, Singapore, Malaysia and Thailand. In 2004, she joined York St John University. First as co-ordinator of the International Foundation Programme, then as Head of Programme for the MA Applied Linguistics: TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages), then as Head of the Department of Languages and Linguistics where she is an active member of their research unit, Language and Identities in Interaction.
